

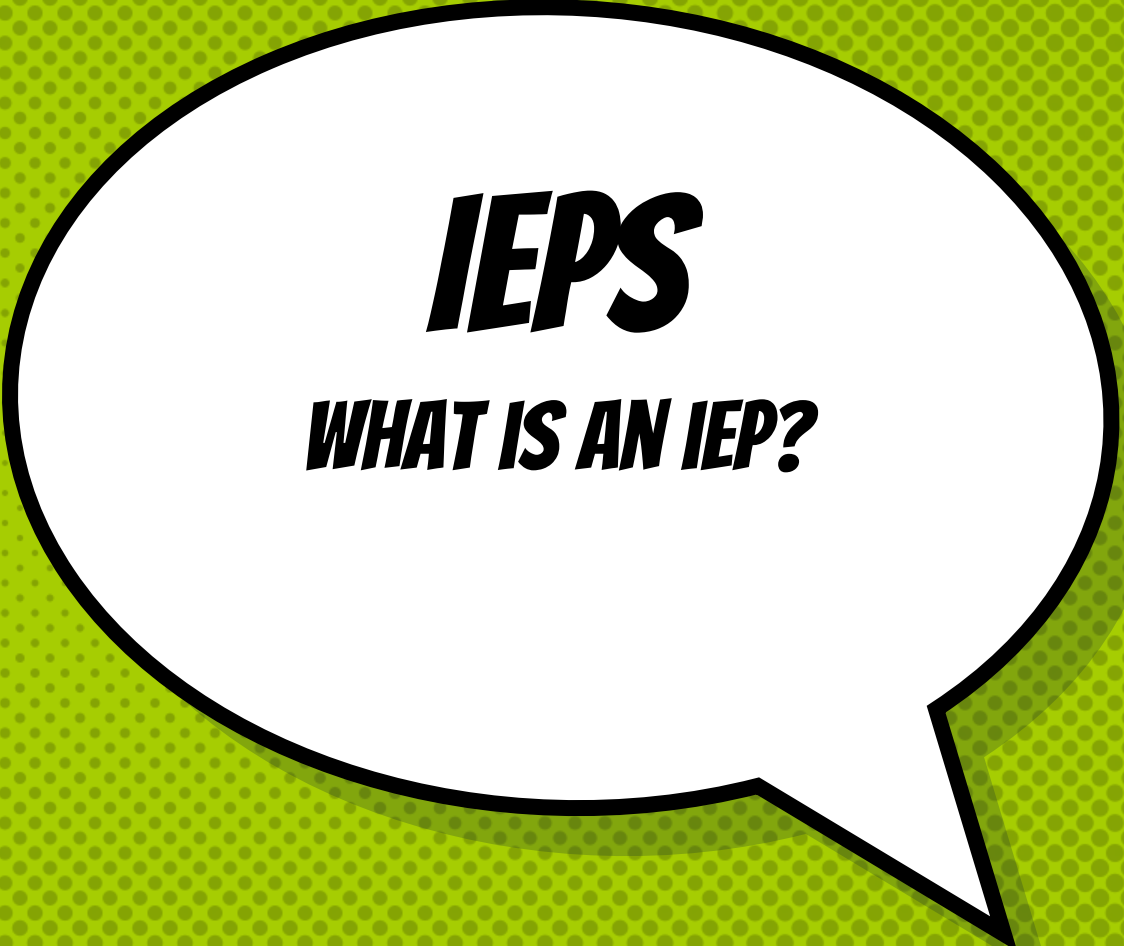

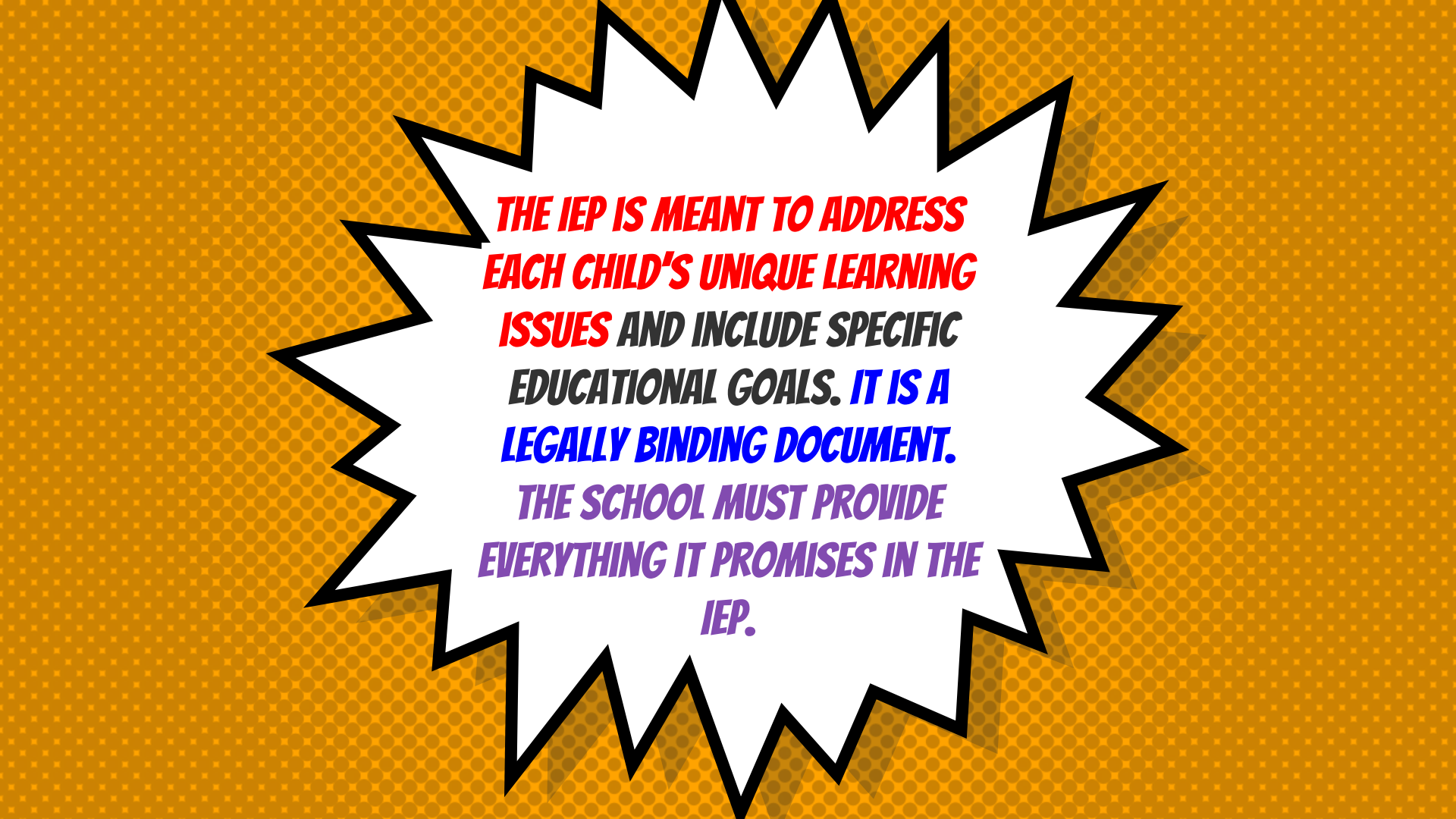

WHAT IS AN IEP?



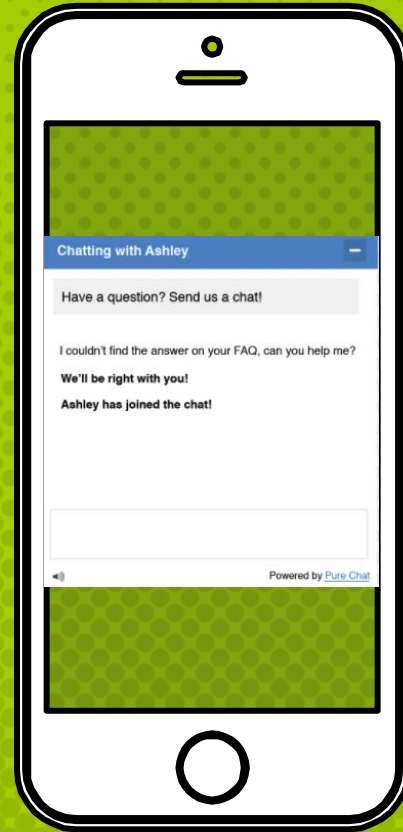
**THE IEP IS MEANT TO ADDRESS

EDUCATIONAL GOALS. IT IS A
LEGALLY BINDING DOCUMENT.

EVERYTHING IT PROMISES IN THE
IEP.**

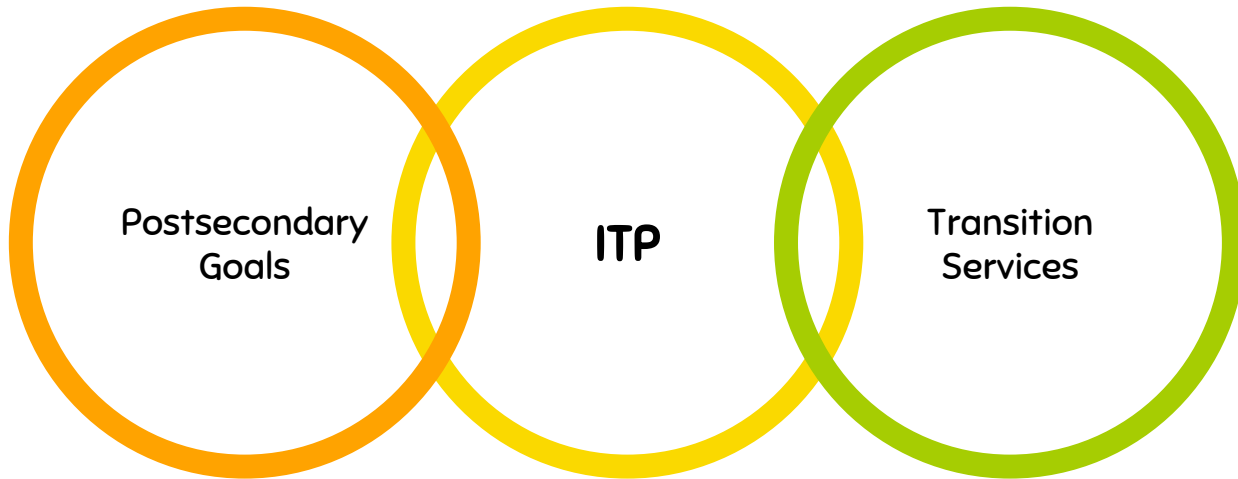


WHY TRANSITION PLANNING?

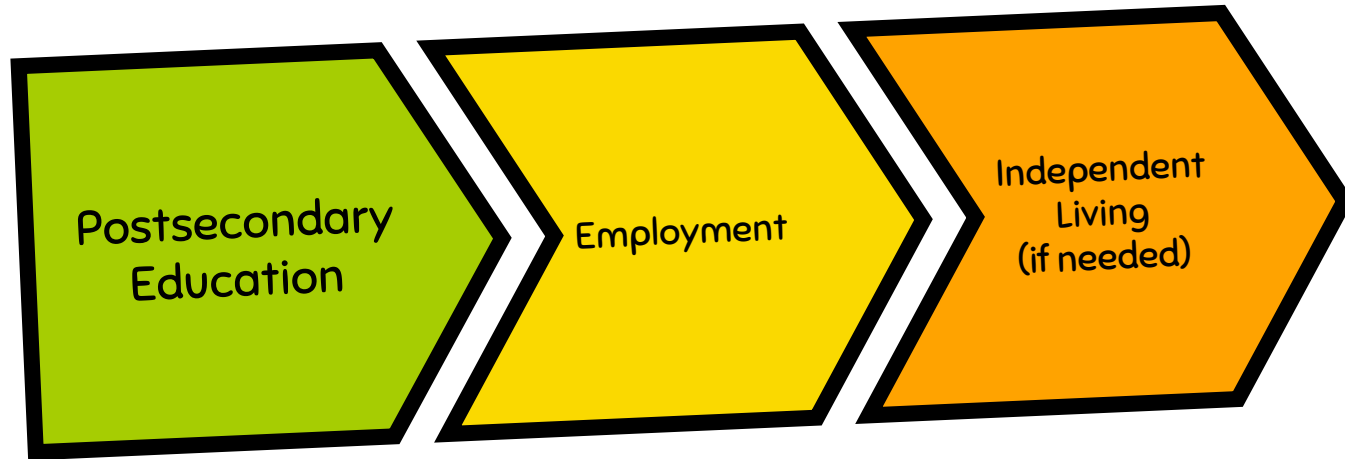
The Law...

OUR GOALS WILL COME FROM 3 AREAS



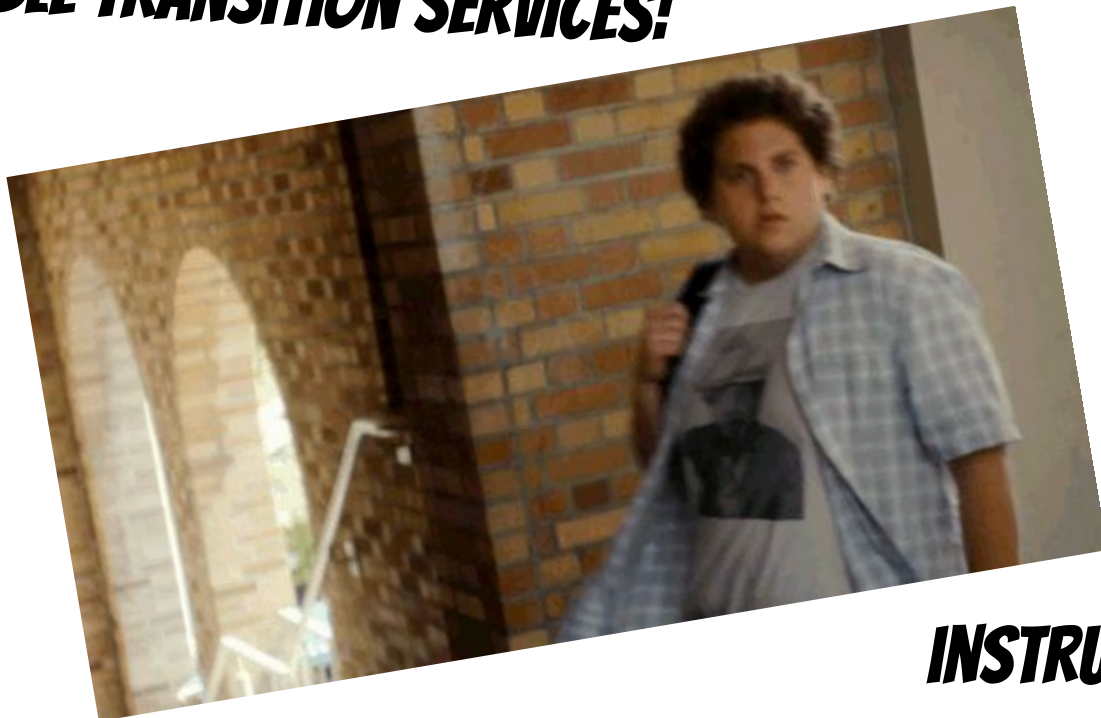
